



Dress Rehearsal/Revue Instructions for Lines

Location of the Revue is at Hastings Middle School Auditorium on 11th and Pine Street.

Comp Finale Rehearsal at studio (no Pre-comp) – Wednesday, May 29th

Dress Rehearsal: Dress rehearsal for lines in **Shows 1 and 4** begins at 3:30 on **Friday, May 31st**. We will practice the finale with just the competition lines from 3:30-4:00, then we will go through the finale with the regular classes and then the entire show in order. **We start to practice the finale with the regular classes at 4:00**. Dancers should **dress after the comp finale practice**. **Dancers who are in all 4 shows who will be participating in the finale in all 4 shows need to attend the finale practice at 6:30 on Friday, May 31st as well. BE ON TIME!!!**

Dress rehearsal for lines in **Shows 2 and 3** begins at **6:30 on Friday, May 31st**. **Routines in all four shows need only practice the finale**. We will practice the finale with just the competition lines from 6:30-7:15, then we will go through the finale with the regular classes and then the entire show in order. This rehearsal will run faster because routines in all 4 shows will only practice during Show 1 & 4 dress rehearsal. Those dancers in all 4 shows can leave after finale practice with the regular classes concludes. **Anyone in all 4 shows needs to attend the 3:30 finale practice as well.**

Anyone who is a class finale helper MUST be at their class's dress rehearsal finale practice. Please stay with them throughout the finale practice. Thanks for your help! During the show you need to line them up in the back hall and stay with them until they are seated on the steps.

Show Days:

Show 1: Saturday, June 1st at 1:30 pm. Be there by 1:00 pm. Doors Open 12:45 PM.

Show 2: Saturday, June 1st at 6:30 pm. Be there by 6:00 pm. Doors Open 5:45 PM.

Show 3: Sunday, June 2nd at 1:30 pm. Be there by 1:00 pm. Doors Open 12:45 PM.

Show 4: Sunday, June 2nd at 6:30 pm. Be there by 6:00 pm. Doors Open 5:45 PM.

Where To Report, Dress and Stay for the Shows:

The Seniors and Teachers will dress in the backstage dressing room. All other lines will dress in the choir room. **NO FOOD OR DRINK (other than water) IN CHOIR ROOM, GYM, or AUDITORIUM. You may eat in the lobby if you clean it up!** Please limit the number of tents. Set them up on perimeter of choir room – NOT in front lower level!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. Revue tickets can be picked up at dress rehearsal in the Middle School auditorium lobby.
2. All fees must be paid in full by May 15th.
3. **All lines should wear JSOD logo wear or JSOD colors with booty shorts and ballet/jazz/tennis shoes for the finale. Pre-comp & non-comp classes will wear their costumes for the finale.**
4. It takes about 4 minutes per number so you can calculate your wait time.
5. The Booster Club will be hosting a fundraiser during the rehearsal/Revue, support the Booster Club by purchasing flowers, water and snacks! Pizza will be sold at dress rehearsal.
6. **Full costume, hair, and makeup are required for each number during dress rehearsal.** People are taping the show. You do not need false eyelashes or new tights.
7. **NO FOOD OR DRINK IN THE AUDITORIUM AT ANY TIME!!!!**
8. No student is allowed in the auditorium during the show UNLESS THEY HAVE A TICKET, which will be checked before each show. **Students MUST have a ticket to enter the auditorium to view any routines or awards in the Revue. Seats are assigned by ticket. No one should be sitting in front or in the aisles.**
9. **If dancers want to congratulate seniors & award winners, they must ENTER from dressing area. Only ticket holders are allowed in the auditorium. Please be respectful and do NOT talk while Jan is giving senior speeches.**

PERFECT ATTENDANCE: If you think you have perfect attendance, please sign the list at the front desk of the studio. These certificates will be handed out in class the last week.

FIVE, TEN AND FIFTEEN YEAR AWARDS: Five-, ten- and fifteen-year **certificates are to be picked up at the studio the last week of class or at the ticket table at the show.** Ten and fifteen year winners will be called onstage to get their award at the show. Five, ten and fifteen year names are on the program.
