



**Instructions for Non-competition Classes and Pre-comp
Dress Rehearsal and Show 1 & 4
Held at Hastings Middle School Auditorium on 11th and Pine Street**

Pictures: Class pictures can be picked up in the lobby of the Middle School at dress rehearsal. Feel free to take pictures & video tape at the dress rehearsal & Revue. Professional video of the revue is available for pre-order - see our website.

TICKET ORDER: Forms may be turned in at the studio beginning on May 12 from 5-7pm. Forms are numbered as they are received. The lower the number, the closer the seats are to the stage. Tickets are filled on a first-come first-served basis. You may mail order forms to the studio, but they will not be numbered until May 13. **Tickets can be picked up at dress rehearsal in the Middle School auditorium lobby.** Presale tickets are \$12 and those sold at the door are \$14. Any changes after the initial order require a ticket change form be turned in to the office.

Dress Rehearsal: Friday, May 31st at 4:00 for Shows 1 & 4.

Come in full costume and makeup. Report to the section of the auditorium that is labeled with your class day and time. The finale is practiced first. The show will then be practiced in order. The show order is on the back of this handout. Have your child in the hall by the back stage door five numbers before they are to go on stage. You are free to leave after your number has been practiced. If you are late in the program, you may want to leave after the finale and return later. It takes about 4 minutes per number so you can calculate your wait time. **The Booster Club will be hosting a fundraiser during the rehearsal & Revue. Support the Booster Club by purchasing flowers, water and snacks! Pizza will be sold at dress rehearsal.**

SHOWS 1 AND 4 INFORMATION AND SCHEDULE:

Show 1---Saturday, June 1st at 1:30PM. Arrive by 1:00PM. Doors Open: 12:45PM

Show 4— Sunday, June 2nd at 6:30PM. Arrive by 6:00PM. Doors Open: 5:45PM

*****NO FOOD OR DRINK IS ALLOWED IN THE AUDITORIUM AT DRESS REHEARSAL OR ANY OF THE SHOWS*****

There is an area to wait in the back hallway if you are not buying tickets. This area is not supervised so an adult needs to stay with your dancer. Pre-schoolers do not need a ticket if they sit on a lap. Just take them with you to the auditorium. **Numbers 1-8 report to the staging hallway 15 minutes before show time. All students Kindergarten and up must have a ticket to go to the auditorium.** If the student is to be in the auditorium, be sure they are back to the practice area in the hall 5 numbers prior to going on stage. If they are numbers 1-8, all will stay with the supervisor until they perform. All students are to be back stage 4 numbers before the finale. All students need to be picked up in the hallway after their routine, we do **NOT** supervise the lobby area, but an adult may stay there with the dancer while waiting for the finale.

FINALE: All non-competition and pre-comp classes should wear their costumes and ballet/jazz/tennis shoes for the finale. All students will report to the back hall 4 numbers before the end of the show to get in line for the finale. Check the chart on the door to see about where they are in the lineup. Toddler classes may participate in the finale, but will come forward to sit on the stage stairs from the audience. After the finale, Jan will dismiss the students and you will pick them up from the front of the stage.

DOORS IN AUDITORIUM THAT CAN BE USED: The rear center door is the only door anyone may enter or exit the auditorium. You can only enter or exit the auditorium between numbers, not during. Please be courteous to those around you and do not obstruct others' view. Please come early, it is difficult to find your seats for the first time once the show begins and it's dark. The side door of the auditorium is not to be used at all.

PERFECT ATTENDANCE AND YEAR END DANCE AWARD: If you think you have perfect attendance, please sign the list at the front desk. Please pick up these certificates the last week of class or near the ticket table at the show.

FIVE, TEN AND FIFTEEN YEAR AWARDS: Five-, ten- and fifteen-year certificates will be given out the last week of class. If you did not get yours, pick it up at the ticket desk in the lobby at the show, or it will be discarded. Ten and fifteen year winners will be called onstage to get their award at the show. Five, ten and fifteen year names are on the program.
